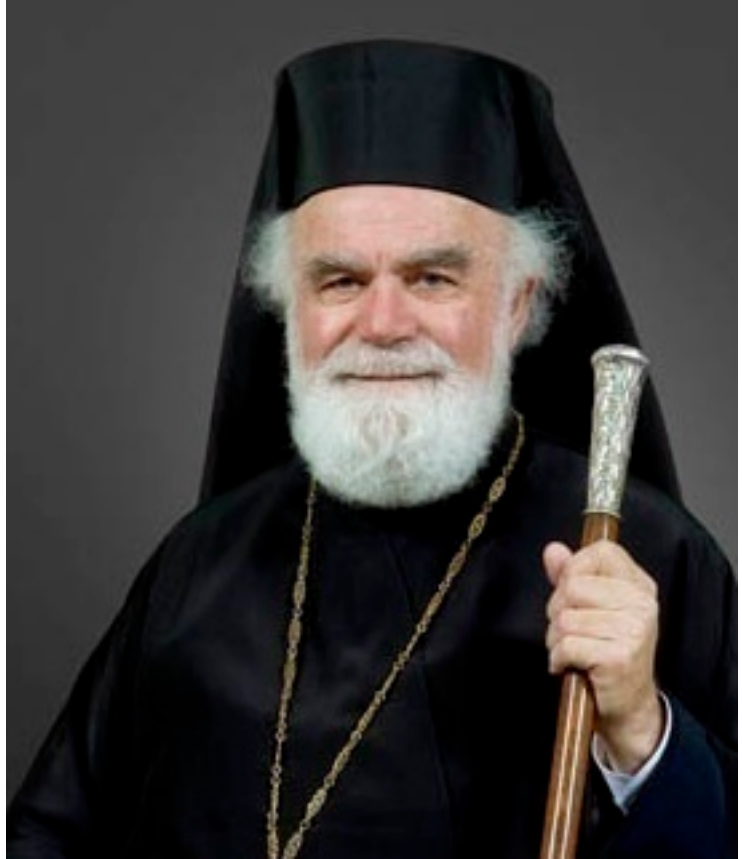


My Beloved,
